CrimeWeb is an integrated collection of law enforcement software applications for capturing, managing and analyzing information about crimes and other non-crime incidents.

At the core of CrimeWeb is the Incident Reporting Management System. The system is designed to be used from mobile units or in the station. Either way, users will utilize familiar Web based technologies such as Internet Explorer.

In the units or in-house, CrimeWeb puts access to your critical information into your favorite Web browser.

Reports can be entered, reviewed, updated or browsed in real time regardless of location. Full application security dictates the capabilities of each user.

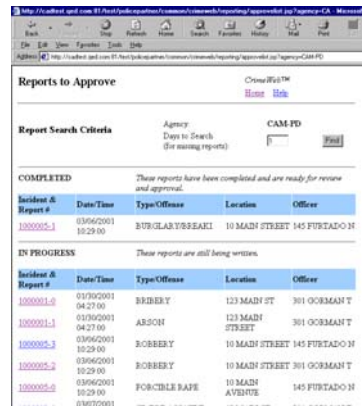
Powerful searching tools help you find what you're looking for.



Use the Web-based Journals and Logs to see Department activity (CAD incidents, arrest/bookings, police reports, etc.) at a glance, or use the QuickFind feature to pull up a particular case or report.

Organize the case load!

Supervisors can retrieve a shift log of reports due for review, rejection or approval. Rejected reports are sent back to the user for modification. Best of all, users see only those reports that concern them.

Put your data together.

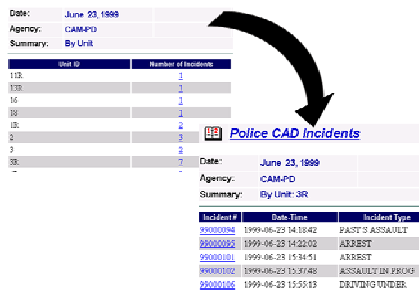
Hyperlinks take you from CAD Incident to Police Report to Arrest History to Booking Sheet, all with a few clicks.
