Use the Web-based Journal to see Department activity (CAD incidents, arrest/bookings, police reports, etc.) at a glance, or use the *QuickFind* feature to pull up a particular case or report.

## Important Attributes of Police/Journals

### *Supports Many Configurations*

Police/Journals is available for Q.E.D.'s CAD/97 or Classic CAD software, and for NIBRS or UCR-based Police Reporting configurations.

### *Live Data Publishing*

The data displayed in Police/Journals pages is drawn live from your on-line database. As soon as an update is made, it is available to personnel browsing the pages.

### *Flexible Access Security*

Police/Journals pages can be accessed within your Department, or by selected outside personnel at your discretion. If your network has a Virtual Private Network gateway, you can provide secure access to mobile users via CDPD, or to personnel working from their homes or other remote locations.

### *Bundled Software*

Police/Journals comes with the Q.E.D. Web/Partner platform that utilizes the industry-leading [JRun Application Server](#) from Allaire Corp., for fast, secure Web access to the database.

### *Ease of Administration*

Software is installed on a central intranet Web server (Web/Partner). Unlike traditional Windows™ software, new versions can be easily installed without having to update software on many PCs.

### *System Requirements*

Police/Journals works in conjunction with Web/Partner.

- A Local Area Network (LAN) with a Windows-NT Server™ running Microsoft Internet Information Server (IIS) is required to provide Web services. Q.E.D. supplies this server with the Web/Partner product.
- Police/Journals and Web/Partner can be purchased with a pre-configured Windows NT Server for easiest and quickest setup.
- Works with Informix™ On-Line Dynamic Server™ or Informix Standard Engine™ on Unix or NT Server platforms. (Unix is required if the system is also being used for the CAD/Partner™ Computer Aided Dispatch software.)
- Users access Police/Journals and Web/Partner through Microsoft Internet Explorer™ browser.
